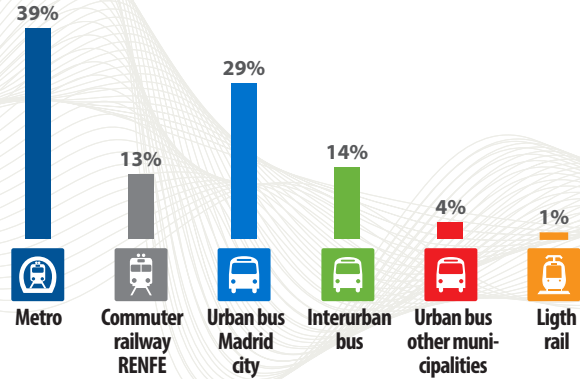
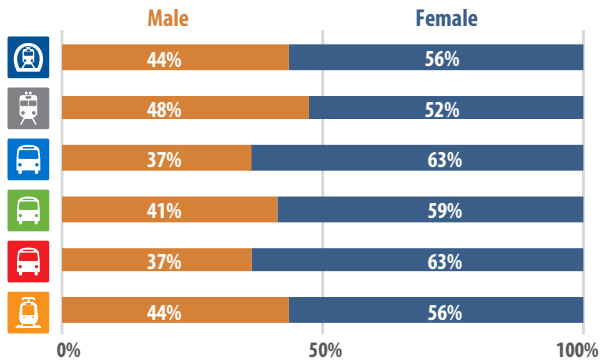

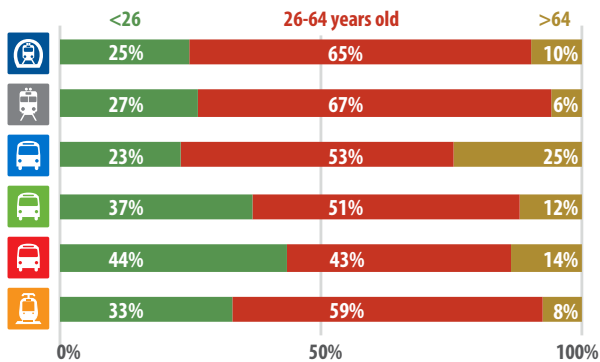
Over 5 million trips are made daily in Madrid Region on the different public transport modes.

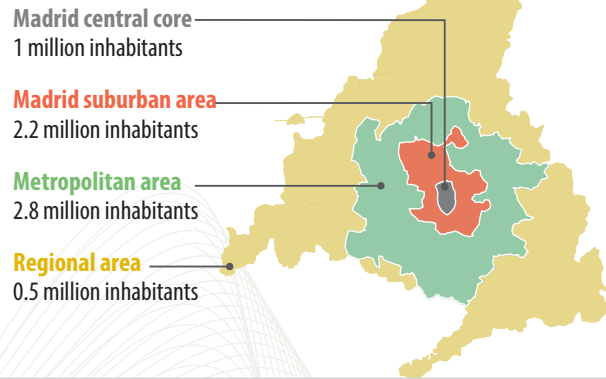

The **edM2018** aims to collect and analyze the mobility of residents over 3 years old in Madrid Region. As such, **85,064 people** have been interviewed to know their mobility patterns.

-  **13,000** face-to-face **household** surveys
-  **50,000** telephone surveys
-  **1,259** transport zones
-  During working days from February to May 2018

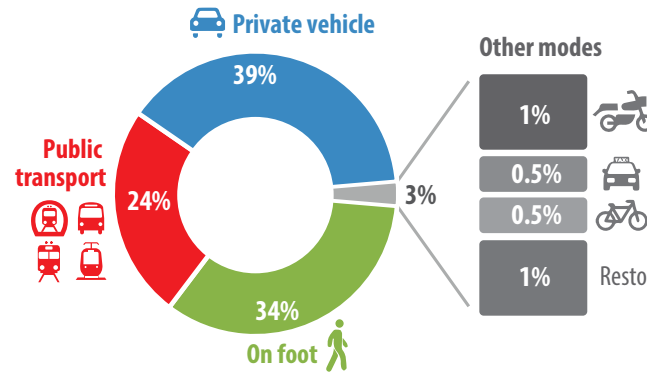
SOCIOECONOMIC DATA

-  **6.5 million** inhabitants residing in Madrid Region
-  Madrid Municipality holds **49%** of the population and **60%** of the jobs in Madrid region
-  **2.6 million** households with an average size of **2.52** people per family
-  Car-ownership is **429** cars per **1,000** inhabitants

GLOBAL MOBILITY

15.8 million daily journeys are made in Madrid Region, being **2.4 journeys per person** on an average working day.

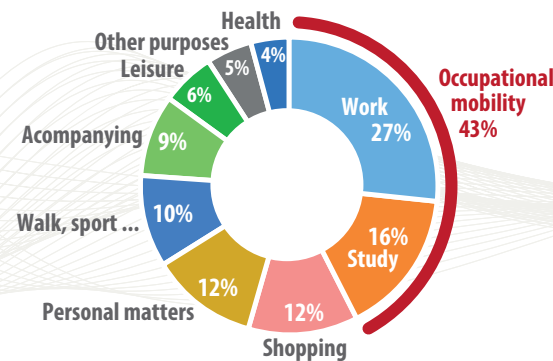
MODAL SHARE



Two out of three journeys are made on public or private motorized vehicles
(10.5 million journeys)

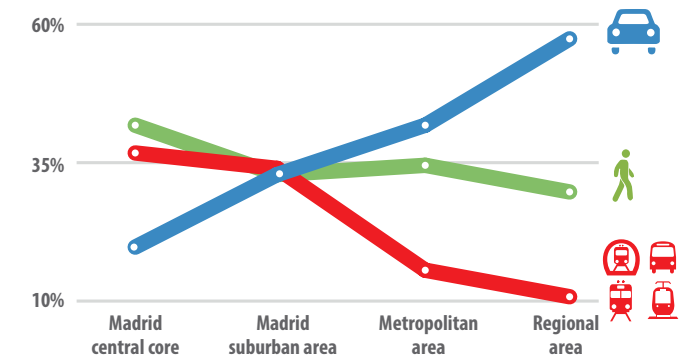
